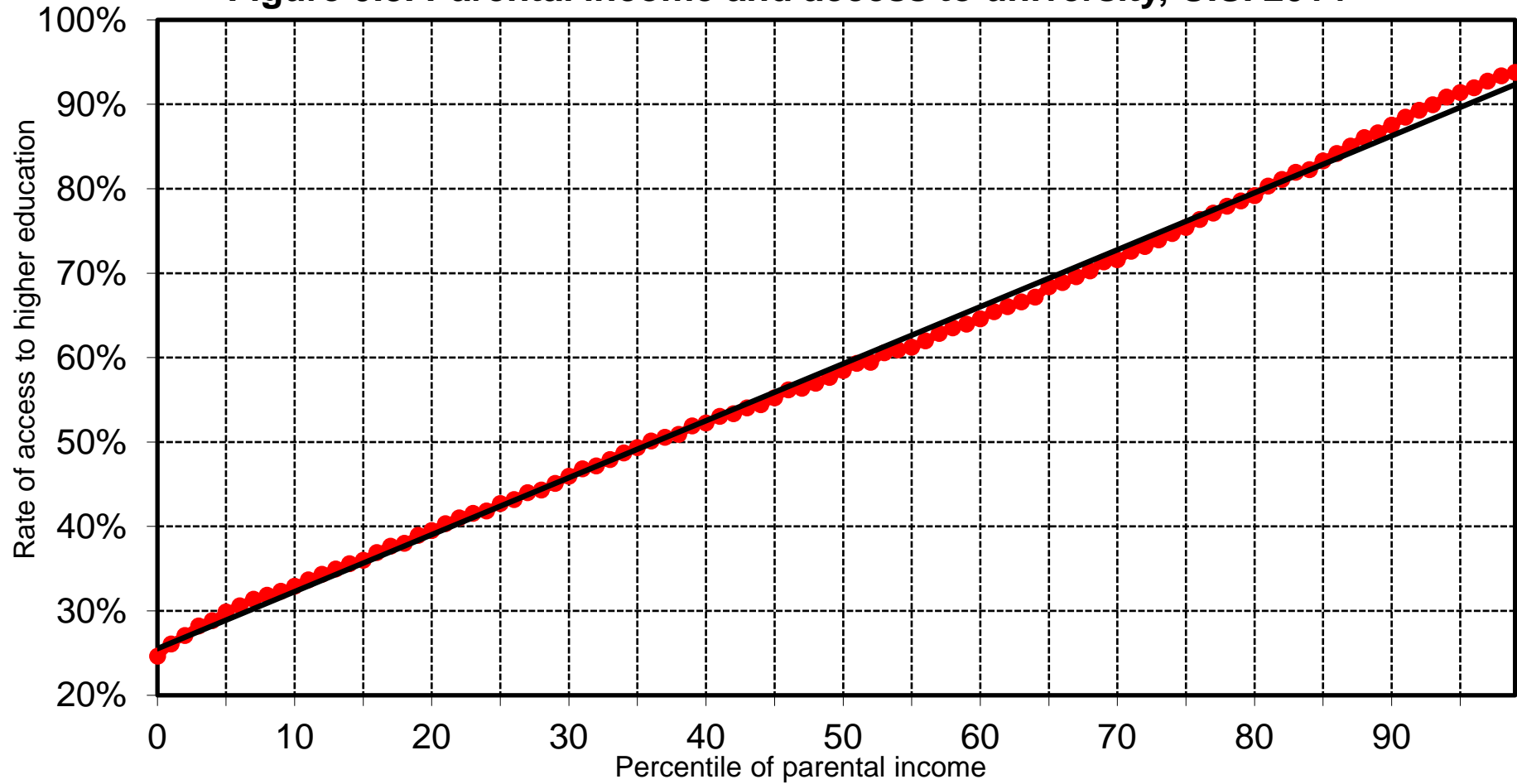


Figure 0.8. Parental income and access to university, U.S. 2014
